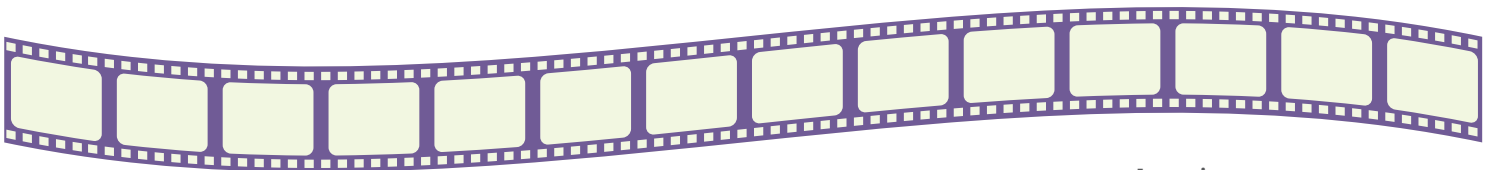

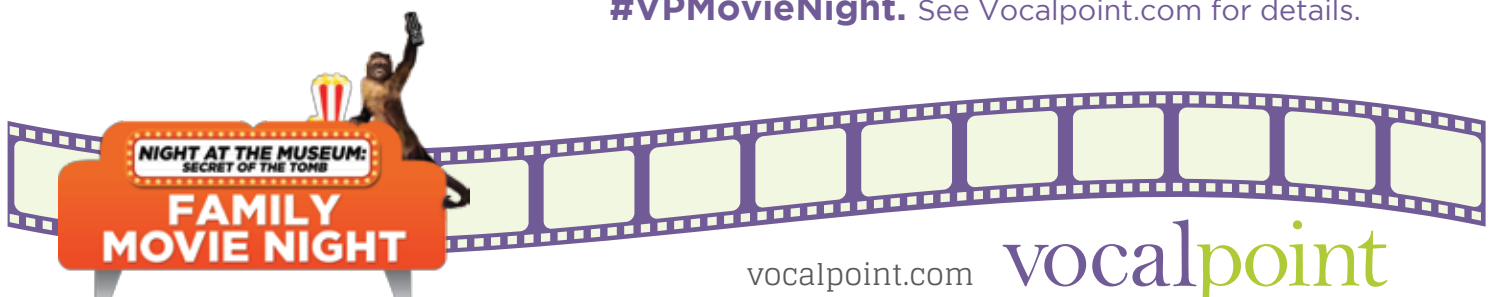

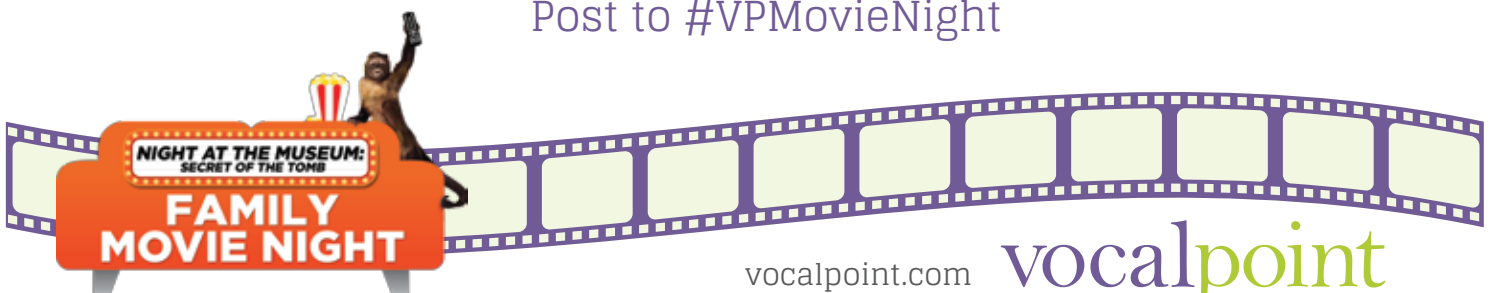

- **printable** sword



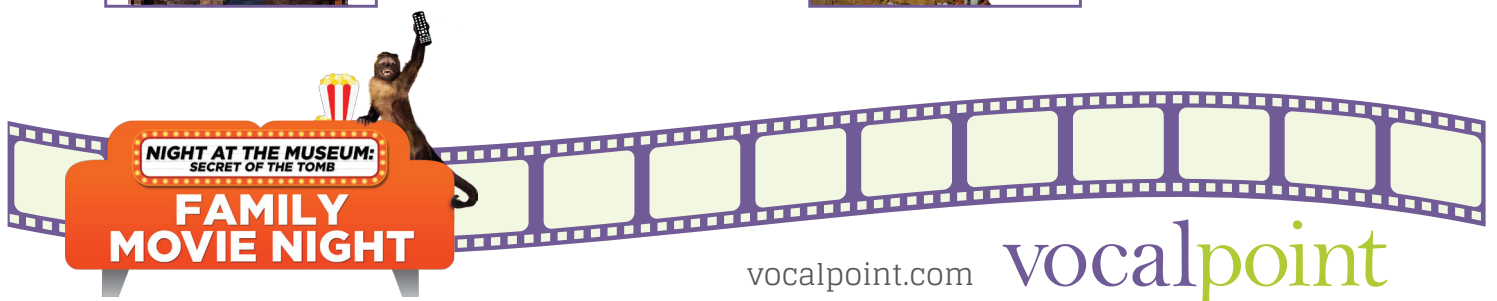
## Cowboy/Cowgirl Jedediah

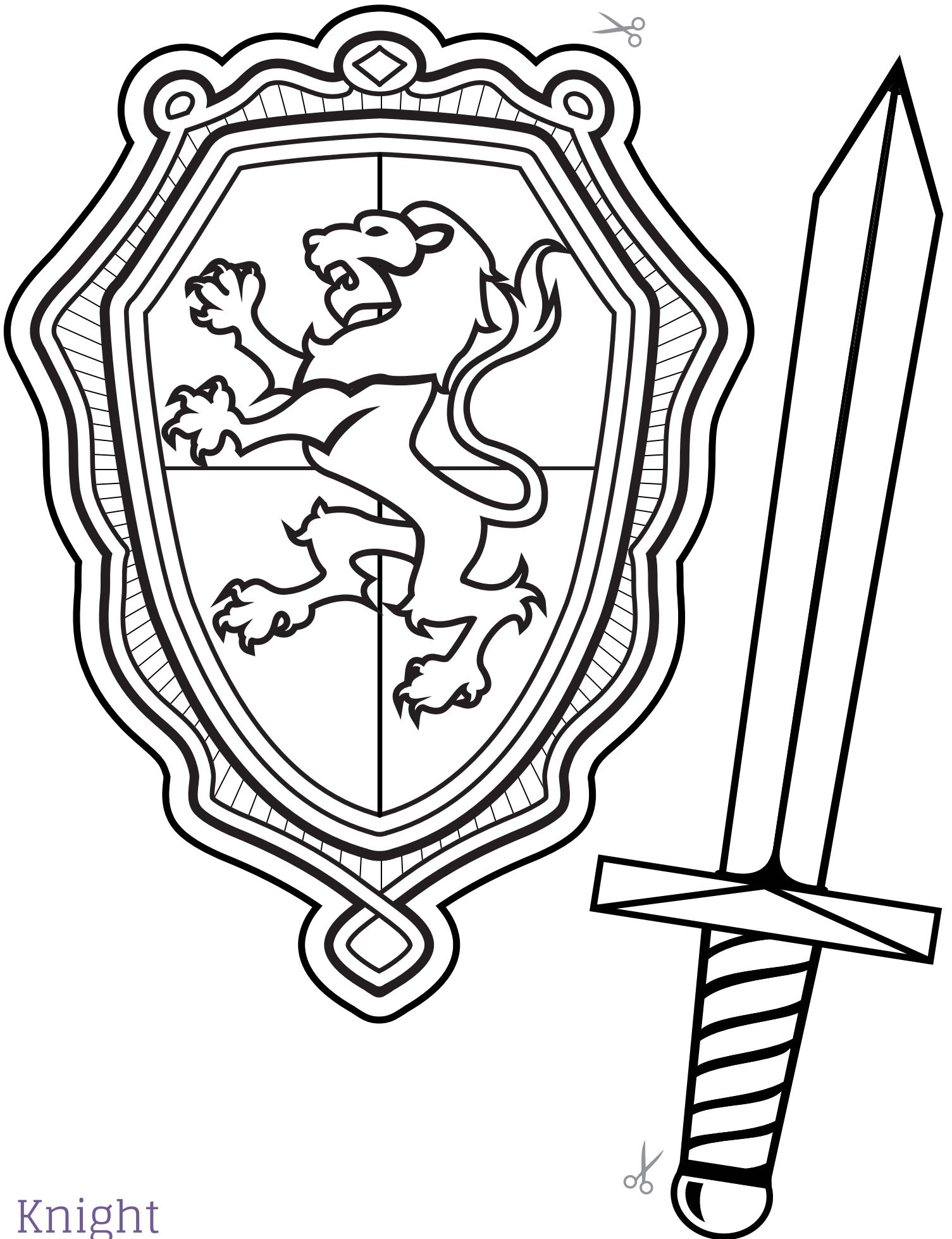
- cowboy hat

## Native American Sacajawea

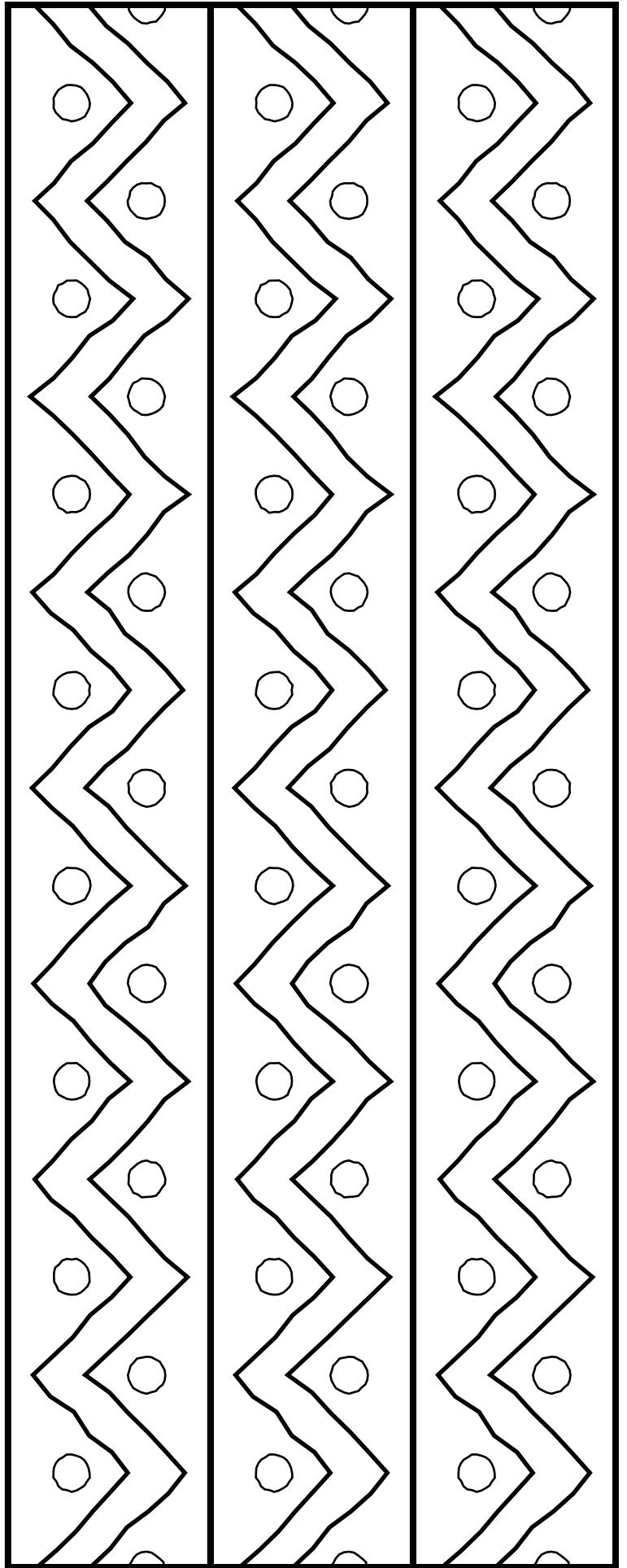
- wear tan or earthy color clothing – maybe dad's old tshirt cut into fringe along the edges?

- add **printable** feather headdress

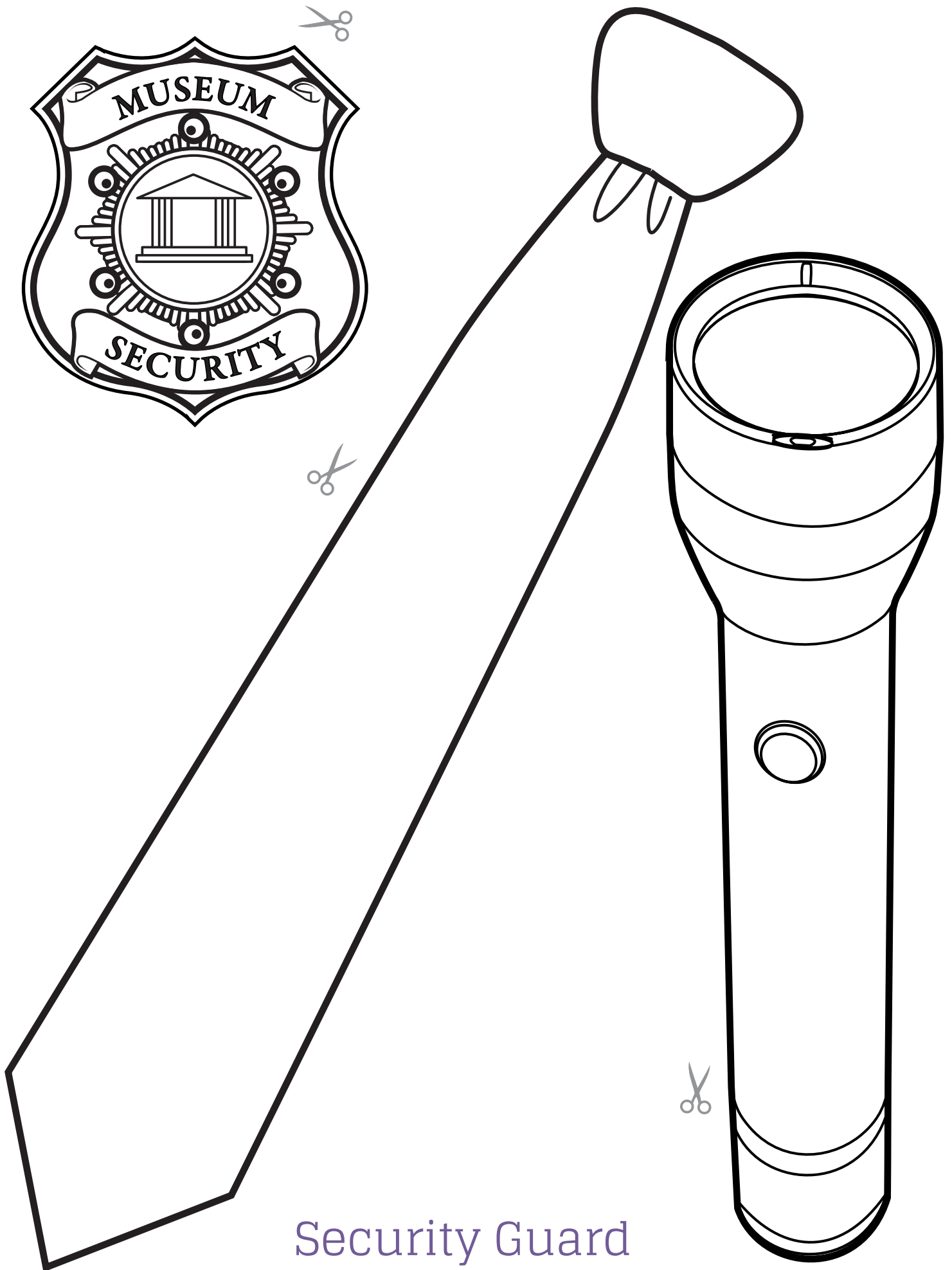




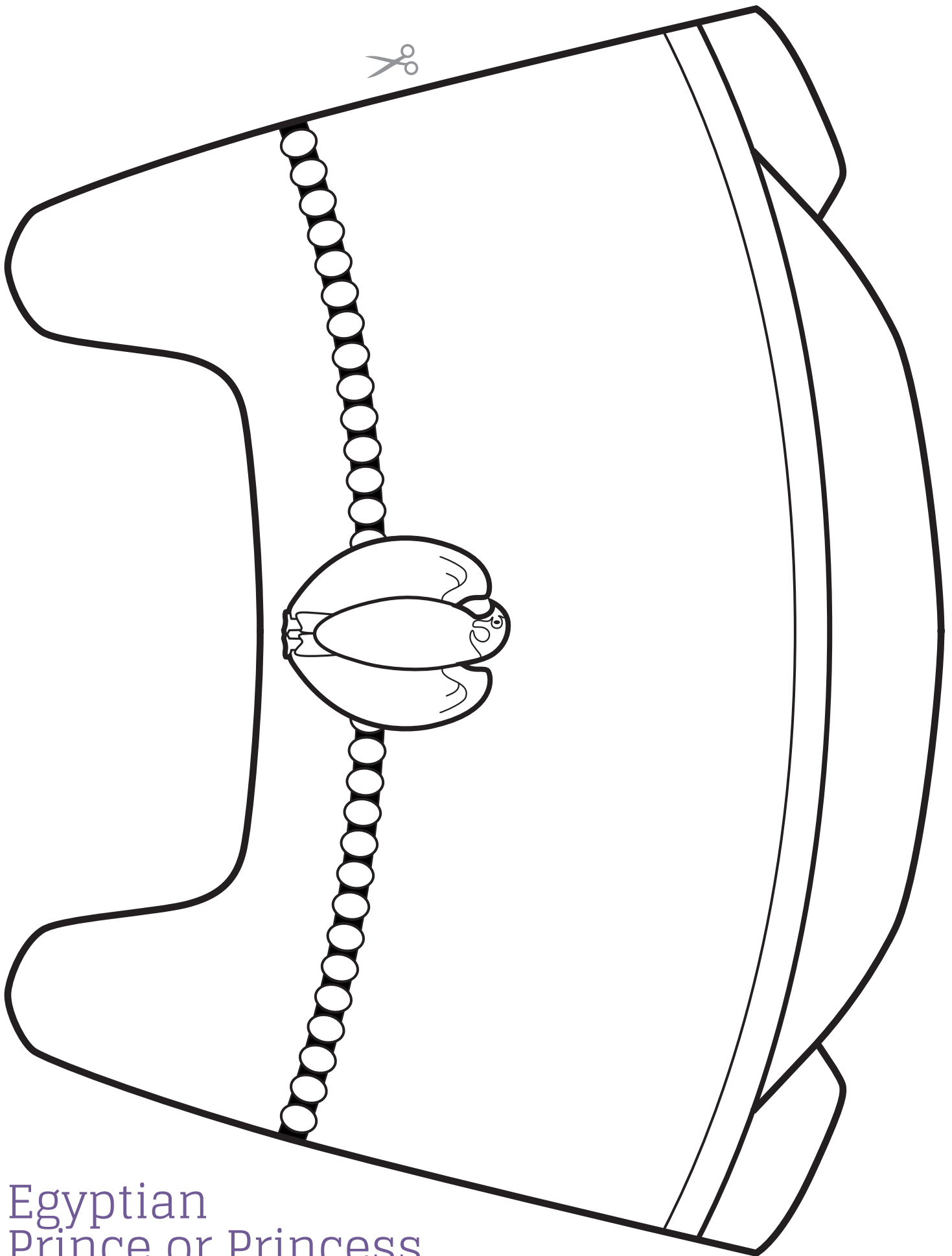
